



The National Pigeon Association Junior Scholarship Program

A few years ago the NPA established a fund for deserving Junior members that wished to enter College.

Eligibility

- To be eligible the Junior member has to be in good standing in the NPA for a minimum of three years.
- He or She must submit a transcript of their High School grades for the Secretary of the NPA by July 15th of the Calendar year of their graduation. Included should be the history of any extra curricular activities, such as sports, 4-H program participation, Academic Clubs, etc.
- A GPA of a B is required throughout the High School years.
- If there are extenuating circumstances concerning the GPA the committee will take that into consideration. That information must be submitted in writing along with the application for an award.
- There is also a second requirement about the Pigeon Hobby and how the applicant has participated in it and what the hobby means to them.
- The award consists of a dollar value of \$750.00
- There will be three awards given as long as the fund stays solvent.
- Any Junior member will be granted this award only once
- The award will be available only the High School graduates who are enrolling in an accredited two or four year institution of higher learning.

The Scholarship advisory committee consists of the NPA President, the Eastern and Western Vice Presidents and the Junior Director.

This fund depends on the generosity of the NPA members and affiliated organizations. The auction at the National Convention is the funds largest contributor. The NPA will donate any royalties that are received from the Credit card program.

Please be assured that all funds designated for the scholarship fund will be used for that purpose and only that purpose. This fund is in a separate account and an accounting of such will be available to every member on request.
